PART - A

I. DEFINITIONS

- i) **“Bidder”** means a bidder/firm/agency who has responded to this Tender Document by submitting his Technical and Financial Proposal.
- ii) **“Contract”** means the contract signed between the Kolkata Police and the successful bidder pursuant to the tender document herein.
- iii) **“Contract Price”** means the price to be paid to the Contractor for providing the intended solution, in accordance with the Contract.
- iv) **“Contractor”** means the successful Bidder whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by Kolkata Police and is named as such in the Letter of Intent (LoI)/Letter of Acceptance (LoA).
- v) **“Government”** means the Government of West Bengal.
- vi) **“Party”** means Kolkata Police or the Contractor, as the case may be, and **“Parties”** means both of them.
- vii) **“Services”** means the work to be performed by the contractor including the supply of related accessories, transportation, insurance, customization, commissioning, training, technical support, maintenance, repair, and other services necessary for proper operation of the intended equipment to be provided by the contractor and as specified in the Contract.

II. INTRODUCTION

One of the primary objectives of Kolkata Police is to enhance safety and security, improve efficiency of services and promote a better quality for the citizens. In order to achieve these objectives, Kolkata Police desires to foster the development of a robust ICT Infrastructure that supports digital applications and appliances to ensure seamless steady operations for traffic management, traffic enforcement and thus enhance public safety.

As a significant step towards transforming the city of Kolkata in to a Global City, the Traffic Wing of Kolkata Police has decided to upgrade its current capabilities by leveraging leading technology – based tools and be able to deliver policing services that are on par across Global Cities. This is in line with the State Mission Statement “Safe Drive, Save Life”.

The vision of the Project is to augment the existing IP based Surveillance Camera Network by replacing/ installing 300 Cameras at different existing locations/new locations, as detailed later. The Cameras should seamlessly integrate with the existing Network, Video Management Application and Video Wall.

III. SCOPE OF WORK

Kolkata Police, under the purview of this project has planned to install/replacement of 300 IP based Surveillance Cameras at different locations.

The selected System Integrator (SI) will be responsible for successful implementation and delivery of the following systems and capabilities linked with each system :

- a) Procurement of 300 new IP based Surveillance Cameras.
- b) Seamless integration of IP Backbone with Surveillance Application consisting of IP Based Surveillance Cameras and Intelligent Monitoring and Recording System and the same needs to be shown by the System Integrator during demonstration, if held.
- c) Installation of cameras at different locations with appropriate arrangements to be done by L1 bidder.
- d) Cameras to be connected with the existing infrastructure with CAT6 and power cable by L1 bidder.
- e) Cameras to be configured by L1 bidder as per network settings provided by the Kolkata Police.

IV. PRE-BID QUALIFICATIONS

1. **Company Registration :**

The responding Bidder should be registered under statutes of India. The organization should be of repute and be incorporated/registered in India.

2. **Trade Licence/Professional Tax/IT Return :**

The responding Bidder should have valid Trade Licence issued by the competent authority for similar type of works and also valid Professional Tax Certificate & Income Tax Clearance Certificate.

3. Undertaking Regarding Blacklisting :

- a) The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertaking for the tendered item and/or any other item. An undertaking in this regard should be submitted by the bidder in the form of affidavit (Annexure-III), otherwise the bid shall be summarily rejected.
- b) If the selected firm is found/detected Blacklisted by any Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertaking (for the tendered item or any other item) at any stage of procurement process, the acceptance of the selected firm and/or the supply order etc., if issued would be treated as cancelled and the contract in whole will be terminated with immediate effect without any intimation to the concerned firm.
- c) In this case the EMD/SD will be forfeited and the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right to initiate the proceedings against the selected vendor. In this regard, the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right to select the second lowest (L2) vendor for supply of the tendered item. The decision taken by Kolkata Police authority in the matter will be treated as full & final in this regard. The bidders will have to furnish an undertaking in this matter in the form as given in Annexure-III.

4. Undertaking Regarding Acceptance of the Terms & Conditions :

The bidders shall have to submit an undertaking regarding acceptance of the Terms & Conditions of the NIT in Annexure-I.

5. Insolvency/Criminal Activities :

In case of Partnership/other Firm –

- a) None of the partners/owner should be insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up and their affairs are not being administered by the Court or a judicial officer, their business activities have not been suspended and subjected to any legal proceedings.
- b) None of the partners/owner should have been convicted of any criminal offence related to professional conduct or of the making of false statement or misrepresentation as to their qualifications.
- c) The act of the breach of performance of the contract by any of the partners shall be binding on the firm.
- d) The bidder shall be construed to mean the prime bidder and all clauses as are applicable to a bidder shall also be applicable to the prime bidder.

6. Annual Turnover :

The bidder is desirable to have had an Annual Turnover of **Rs. 50.00 lakhs only** for the last financial year. **A certificate from Chartered Accountant should be attached stating the annual turnover.**

7. Credentials :

Documents in the form of work completion certificates & payment certificates of executing similar nature of works have done **not less than 50%** of the estimated cost, which is applicable for eligibility in this tender.

8. Work Experience :

The Bidder is desirable to have experience in the relevant field for at least last 3 (three) years.

9. PAN No. :

The bidder should have in its name PAN (Permanent Account Number) with Income Tax authority in India.

10. Goods & Services Tax (GST) :

The bidder should have Goods & Services Tax Identification Number (GSTIN) in India in its name.

11. Employees/Manpower under the Bidder :

The bidders should have sufficient no. of technically qualified support staff on their roles. **A declaration in this respect has to be submitted.**

12. Authorization/OEM Certificate :

1. OEM producing the item proposed by the bidder shall not have been blacklisted by any State/Central Government Department or Central or State PSUs/Army/Navy/Airforce/CAPF/RPF/ Indian Railways/Other Govt. Entities/Globally as on bid submission date.
2. Copy of **Tender Specific Authorization Certificate** from Manufacturer should be submitted (Annexure-V) otherwise the bid may be rejected. **Any representation through a Dealer/Distributor/Joint Venture/consortium/subsidiary shall not be treated as OEM.**

13. OEM Qualification Criteria :

- a) OEM of Camera should have its own company registered in India (under Incorporation of Companies Act, 1956/ 2013) since last 10 years. Any representation through a Dealer/ Distributor/ Subsidiary/ consortium shall not be treated as OEM. This must be supported by necessary statutory documents. CCTV OEM should have manufacturing unit in India since last Five years and Foreign CCTV OEM should have manufacturing unit globally from last 10 Years.
- b) OEM of Camera should not be a company having its major shareholding stake by any government or its entity or originated/founded by personnel of Defence origin or directly connected with land border countries.
- c) OEM of Camera should not be blacklisted or banned by any country or government department in any country. The OEM should not have any cheating or fraud case filed against their company for their respective product line.
- d) OEM of Camera should be fulltime member of ONVIF, and quoted model should be listed on ONVIF official website (All the certifications & Credentials should be valid on the date of technical evaluation). The OEM should not be suspended/ blacklisted by ONVIF.
- e) OEM of Cameras should have below ISO Certifications for Quality, Environment, Security management, Health & Safety Management system and Cyber Security for manufacturing of all types of Cameras. OEM should have the following Certifications:
 - i) ISO9001:2015
 - ii) ISO 14001:2015
 - iii) ISO 27001:2013
 - iv) ISO 45001:2018
 - v) ISO/IEC 27032:2012
- f) OEM of Camera should be a genuine manufacturer and should have an official valid H.265 HEVC certificate and should be listed on HEVC website at the time of submitting bid. They should be paying the licensed fee for using the genuine HEVC compression legally. The same will be checked on following official website: <https://www.mpegla.com/programs/HEVC/licensees/>
- g) OEM of Camera should comply with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) & Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE).
- h) OEM of Camera should have its office and service / support centre in India preferably in Kolkata.
- i) OEM of Camera should comply with "Make-in-India" policy and guidelines as laid by Government of India. The OEM should also comply with all subsequent guidelines and orders published by various departments of Government of India such as Department of Expenditure (Ministry of Finance).
- j) OEM of Camera should have supplied at least 1,00,000 IP CCTV cameras during the last 05 years to any State Govt. / Central Govt. / Public sector undertaking in India, as on bid submission date.
- k) OEM of Camera should be an affiliated Industry Training Partner of an appropriate, active, and approved training council of NSDC in field of Electronic Security/CCTV/Video Surveillance or similar for a period of minimum two years.
- l) Mac ID of the product must be registered on the name of OEM. OEM must be full Member of ONVIF.
- m) OEM brand should have established in India at least three (03) years and globally for at least 5 to 10 years. Supporting document should have to be submitted.
- n) OEM should have online helpline and offline dedicated CCTV support centre available during 24x7 and a fully equipped repair & maintenance office under KMDA area. OEM document details to be submitted for the same.
- o) The Authorized Bidder should possess an Authorization Certificate directly from the OEM and the same should be submitted in the physical and digital formats.
- p) The CCTV OEM should have ZED certification issued by the MSME and Quality Council of India (QCI).
- q) CCTV OEM should have their own factory in India.
- r) CCTV OEM should have their own R&D in India to develop, test and support country-specific security, country-specific IVA algorithms and such other patches.
- s) Proposed CCTV OEM should have dedicated, toll-free telephone numbers for after-sales support.
- t) The CCTV products should have been researched, designed and manufactured in India.
- u) CCTV Camera should support ONVIF (Profile S, G, T) Model should be listed on the ONVIF website or ONVIF Report should be submitted.

- v) Bidder/OEM should provide escalation matrix defining who should handle incidents at each escalation level with names and contact details for each level.
- w) The Bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS certificate, type test certificate, approval certificates and other such certificates as prescribed in the Product Specifications given in the bid document
- x) Datasheets of the product(s) offered in the bid are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Datasheets with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
- y) OEM should not be blacklisted by any Central/State Govt. Organization, PSU, Public Listed Company or Indian Army.
- z) OEM should demonstrate camera firmware for:
 - i) Malicious code is not embedded in the firmware or software.
 - ii) Hisilicon chipset not used in the products.
- aa) CE and FCC Certifications should be from NABL or ILAC or Govt. accredited laboratories.
- ab) OEM Should submit intellectual Property (IP) resident in India. (for. Ex. Trademark Registration Certificate).
- ac) BIS Certificate as per Indian Standard : 13252 should be available with CCTV OEMs.
- ad) The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of all manufactured final product and source code of all software including firmware should not reside in countries sharing land borders with India, until unless specifically allowed by the Government of India and is registered with the Competent Authority of Government of India. Proof of IPR & source code residing in which country and requisite permission & registration with Competent Authority of Govt. of India, as applicable to comply with the above, shall be provided by the OEMs.
- ae) OEM of Camera should be Fully Compliant to Section 889 of National Defence Authorization Act-NDAA. OEM undertaking is required.
- af) STQC Test certificate after security auditing and testing of equipment including source code of camera and software.

14. Proprietary Article Certificate :

In case the bidder is **OEM** i.e. Manufacturing Units, he will have to submit authentic documents/ Propriety Article Certificate.

15. Solvency Certificate :

The Bidder is desirable to submit a Solvency Certificate from a Bank/CA equivalent to the Estimated Cost put to tender.

V. INFORMATION FOR THE BIDDER

1. Office for Communication :

The Bidder must have permanent operational office under KMDA jurisdiction (provide Trade Licence evidencing the address). The Bidder should mention in detail their support infrastructure including Address, Contact Phone/Mobile No., Fax No., e-Mail ID etc. and modalities by which fast response to maintenance calls and minimum downtime will be ensured.

2. Responsibility :

- a) It is the responsibility of the Bidder to submit the bid in the formats given and as per the terms & conditions of the tender documents. In the event of any doubt regarding the terms & conditions/ formats, the Bidder concerned may seek clarifications from the authorized offices of Kolkata Police mentioned on [Page.3](#) of this document. If required Kolkata Police may issue corrigendum during this tender period.
- b) All items in the Tender should be clearly mentioned along with its Brand & Parts Serial No. The items may be from different manufacturers, but the Bidders should provide one certificate owning the responsibility of integration along with concerned manufacturers' authorization for such items as well as the existing infrastructure.
- c) The Bidder should also give an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that the Hardware & Software supplied by the vendor is genuine and does not contain/used or any refurbished parts/software and should not have any malware etc.

3. Brochures :

Scan copy Brochures (Product Catalogue) of the item(s) must be uploaded alongwith bid.

4. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) :**

Intending bidder has to deposit the Earnest Money **Rs.1,85,500/- (Rupees one lakh eighty five thousand five hundred)** only through online submission. No alternative will be accepted. Annexure-II may be referred for this purpose.

5. **EMD Exemption :**

Firms registered as a Small Scale Industry/MSME/NSIC/C&SSI Department, West Bengal may, however, be exempted from depositing Earnest Money on production of satisfactory documents in support of their claim.

6. **Taxes & Other Clearance Certificates :**

- All bidders shall have to submit copy of the valid **Trade License, GSTIN and Professional Tax** along with tender on West Bengal e-Tender portal. **Tenders received without such certificates will not be considered.**
- Any claim of GST or any other prevalent Taxes & Duties, if applicable, should be clearly mentioned against the rate of item.

7. **Pre-Bid Meeting :**

Pre-bid Meeting will be held on **19.03.2025 at 15.00 hrs.** in Lalbazar Kolkata Police Headquarters with the interested bidders. Bidder must send their queries through e-mail to Tender Section, KPD (tendersection@kolkatapolice.gov.in) at least before one (01) day of pre-bid meeting. **Participation in the Pre-Bid Meeting will be limited to two persons per bidder along with valid authorization.**

8. **Canvassing :**

Any attempt of canvassing on the part of the bidders will render their tender liable to rejection summarily.

9. **Site Inspection :**

Intending bidders may visit and inspect the site on any working day during office hours under intimation to concerned office.

10. **Type of Bid :**

The tender shall comprise of two-bid systems namely –

- Technical (Fee/PreQual/Technical)** - The technical bid consisting of all technical details along with commercial terms and conditions;
- Financial (Finance)** – Financial bid indicating item-wise price for the items mentioned in the BoQ.

11. **Submission of Bids :**

Tenders are to be submitted online within the prescribed date & time using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).

A) Technical Proposal – Scanned documents (.PDF) will have to be uploaded under the cover named **“Fee/PreQual/Technical”** containing the following folders :

- EMD/Exemption Certificate** (i.e. proof of RTGS/NEFT or SSI/NSIC/MSME certificates),
- NIT** (The .pdf of the NIT may be uploaded directly and digitally signed),
- Technical Documents** (i.e. Compliance of Technical Specifications, Product Catalogue/Brochure etc.),
- Other Important Documents (OID)** – The following documents must be uploaded, otherwise bids could not be submitted online :

Note : Tender/bid documents need not be signed, stamp and scanned for upload. The pdf of the document may be uploaded directly and digitally signed. Unnecessary documents need not be uploaded. Scanning of documents should be at **150 dpi**. File extension type .rar may be discontinued except for World Bank and Asian Development Bank tenders. **Only .pdf files should be uploaded with minimum file size.**

- v) **Other Documents** – (i.e. documents are not listed in the Table above),
- vi) **Checklist** (as per **Annexure-IX**).

B) Financial Proposal –

Financial bid should be uploaded under the cover named “Finance” containing the folder BOQ.

- a) The bidder is to quote the rate online through computer in the space marked for quoting rate in the BoQ. The **base price (rate per unit)** shall be quoted in the space earmarked for the same. **Tax and duties shall have to be mentioned separately in the columns provided for the purpose.**
- b) **The BOQ must not be modified/replaced by the bidder. The bidder should upload the downloaded BOQ after filling the relevant columns; else the bidder is liable to be rejected for that tender. Bidders are allowed to enter the Bidder Name and Values only.**

13. Evaluation Process :

A) Opening of Technical Proposal –

- i) A Committee comprising of senior officers of Kolkata Police will open and assess the Technical bid of the Tender.
- ii) Cover for technical documents will be opened. Decrypted (transformed into readable formats) documents will be downloaded & handed over to the “Tender/Technical Committee”. If there is any deficiency in the documents the tender will summarily be rejected.
- iii) During evaluation the committee may summon the bidders & seek clarification/ information or additional documents or original hard copy of any of the documents already submitted.
- iv) If any bidder fails to produce the original hard copies of the documents on demand of the “Tender Committee” within a specified time frame and if any deviation is detected in the hard copies from the uploaded soft copies, it may be treated as submission of false documents by the bidder and action may be referred to the appropriate authority for prosecution as per relevant law.
- v) Summary list of technically qualified bidders will be uploaded online.

B) Opening of Financial Proposal –

The Financial bids of technically qualified bidders only will be considered for financial bid evaluation. Lowest financial bid will be designated as L1. Second lowest as L2 and so on.

14. Demonstration :

The demonstration of the item/equipment will have to be arranged by the bidder before the Tender committee during technical evaluation on a convenient date after opening of the technical bid. If any or all the items/equipment are not found suitable and/or up to the mark by the members of the Tender Committee, the same shall be liable to be rejected. The decision of Tender Committee and/or any other Committee constituted for the purpose will be taken as final. **The bidder is liable for the cost of equipment/product of demonstration and Kolkata Police will never accept the demonstrated item(s) at the time of delivery.**

15. Tender Acceptance & Rejection :

The following considerations shall be taken into account while evaluating the bids –

- i) Whether the goods and services offered are as per the requisite tender specifications in the document.

- ii) Whether the bidder has submitted all the information/documents as required to be submitted along with the Bid.
- iii) Bidders with variance/contradiction between Technical Bid and Financial Bid will be liable for rejection.
- iv) Bidders submitting incomplete information, subjective and conditional offers as well as partial offers will be liable for rejection.
- v) Tenders with the Technical Bid not containing EMD amount/EMD exemption certificates will be summarily rejected.
- vi) In addition to the above rejection criteria, if there is non-compliance of any of the other clauses of this Tender Document, the tender is liable for rejection.

16. Letter of Intent/Acceptance (LoI/LoA) :

- i) On completion of e-Tender formalities, Letter of Intent (LoI)/Letter of Acceptance (LoA) will be issued in favour of the selected bidder (L1).
- ii) The instant e-tender accepted rate of the tendered items will remain valid for 01 (one) year from the date of issuance of LoI/LoA.
- iii) Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right for placement of work order at any time during the validity period of the tender and the contractor will be bound to execute the work as per accepted rate.

17. Work Order :

Work order will be issued subsequently after completion of required formalities.

18. Security Deposit (SD) :

- i) The contractor shall have to deposit a sum equivalent to **10%** of the total value of the Work Order (excluding admissible Taxes/GST) as Security Deposit in the form of Bank Guarantee/Bank Deposit Receipt, National Savings Certificate issued by the Post Office (P.O.) duly pledged in favour of the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata or in a Savings Bank Pass Book pledged to the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata or in Government Securities endorsed to the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata or FDR (of Scheduled Bank) valid till the expiry of the warranty period and to furnish an undertaking in the prescribed form (Annexure-IV) and also execute an agreement (Annexure-VI) within 10 days from the date of issue of the Work Order failing which the Letter of Acceptance (LoA)/Work Order may liable to be cancelled.
- ii) The Security Deposit will be released after completion of the whole project i.e. after satisfactory completion of the comprehensive warranty period. **Security Deposit will not carry any interest.**
- iii) In the event of the contractor fails to make Security Deposit, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata may, at his discretion, forfeit the earnest money lodged with this tender and cancel the LoI/LoA.
- iv) **No exemption will be allowed from depositing Security Deposit those who have MSME/NSIC certificate.**

19. Additional Performance Security :

- i) The successful bidder shall have to deposit a sum equivalent to **10%** of the total value of the Work Order (excluding admissible Taxes/GST) as Additional Performance Security in the form of Bank Guarantee from a Scheduled Bank, valid up to the warranty period, if the accepted bid value is **80% or less** than the estimated amount put to tender.
- ii) If the successful bidder fails to submit Additional Performance Security within 07 (seven) working days from the date of LoA, his Earnest Money will be forfeited.
- iii) The Additional Performance Security will be released after completion of the whole project i.e. after satisfactory completion of the warranty period. **Additional Performance Security will not carry any interest.**
- iv) In the event of failure to execute the Work Order satisfactory or in the event of default by the bidder, the Additional Performance Security will be forfeited.

20. Warranty & Maintenance :

- a) Contractor will have to give **05 (five) years** comprehensive warranty and maintenance on all components from the date of Go-Live of the project. After completion of comprehensive warranty period Kolkata Police may go for fresh AMC with the supplier **@10%** of total cost excluding network charge. Hence bidder should maintain sufficient stock of spares with them even after the expiry of the warranty period.
- b) The Contractor is liable for repairing all or any sort of damage detected during the warranty period completed free of cost.

- c) During the warranty period no active component should be declared "End of Life". In case it is declared "End of Life" during this period, the vendor has to replace such equipment at their own cost. **A letter of Confirmation by OEM shall be mandatory.**
- d) During warranty period if any camera found not functioning or got damaged, L1 bidder have to replace it with the same camera or camera with higher specification.
21. **Award of Contract :**
The Award of Contract will be notified through West Bengal e-Tender portal.
22. **Delivery/Completion of Work :**
The delivery/completion of work period shall in no case exceed a period of **60 days** of the issuance of Work Order. The Commissioner of Police reserve the right to extend the delivery period against any satisfactory reason thereafter.
23. **Supply of Stores/Execution of Works :**
- The Contractor shall be liable to supply/execute the tendered item as per agreement mutually agreed upon against placement of order of supply from time to time by the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata within the time specified in the respective order. The Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right for placement of Supply/Firm Order at any time during the validity period of the Lol and the Contractor is bound to supply the tendered item as per accepted rate of the respective tender.
 - If the Contractor by any cause, other than his own neglect or default, be prevented or delayed from supplying items/goods as aforesaid, the periods provided in clause may be extended by the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata on being satisfied that reasonable grounds exist for such delay.
 - The Contractor shall provide, at his own expense, all tools, plant, implements, packing, coolie hire charges etc. as will be necessary for the due performance of the contract. No claim on these accounts shall be entertained.
 - Random Testing of the delivered items will also be done at the time of Acceptance at the expense borne by the bidder.
 - Hard & Soft Copies of operating & technical literature both in English are required at the time of supply of the stores.
 - In case of any default/negligence on the part of the Contractor during/after supply of items or execution of work or at any stage of implementation of the project, the Contractor is liable to pay demurrage @5% of total project cost in addition to forfeiture of EMD/SD as the case may be.
24. **Training & Technical Support :**
The after sale training, technical support during Warranty for the tendered item(s) should be done by the Contractor "Free of Cost". **An Undertaking should be submitted along with the bid.**
25. **Work Completion & Liquidated Damages :**
In case of non-completion of work within **60 days**, Kolkata Police shall be entitled to levy and recover Liquidated damages/penalty @0.5% on the total project cost per week or part thereof of the delay subject to maximum 10% of work order if the delay is intentional. However, if the delay is due to any circumstances beyond the control of the contractor no such liquid as per discretion of the authority. Any delay beyond **60 days** may result in cancellation of supply order and forfeiture of SD.
26. **Payment :**
- The process of payment will be initiated only after receiving a satisfactory certificate by the Acceptance Committee to be formed for this purpose after completion of supply/work.
 - The mode of payments to be made in consideration of the work to be performed by the bidder shall be as follows :
 - **50% – After supply of all the CCTV Cameras of the project.**
 - **40% - After Go Live.**
 - **10% – After completion of warranty period.**
27. **Penalty :**
The uptime of the entire system should be 95%. Penalty for non compliance of system uptime will be 0.5% of the project cost for each month.

VI. **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- It should be noted that the Contractor will be selected purely on "PROVISIONAL BASIS".
- Any attempt of canvassing on the part of a bidder will render his tender liable to rejection summarily.

- 3) The Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right to accept any bid, and to annul the bid process and reject all bids at any time, without assigning any reason, prior to placement of supply order/ signing of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder of the grounds thereof.
- 4) This contract shall not be sublet either wholly or partly without the written permission of the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata and on breach of this provision the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata may cancel the contract and forfeit the Security Deposit and the Contractor shall have no claim for loss thereby resulting to him on any account whatsoever.
- 5) Any breach by the Contractor of any of the terms of the contract, the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata may, in addition to recovering any loss to sustain, terminate the contract on seven (07) days notice to the Contractor. The decision of the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata shall be the final on all questions as to the extent, meaning or construction of the said schedule or any descriptions, prices or other matters therein.
- 6) In the event of failure to supply the articles/execute the work according to approved commodities/ samples as agreed upon by the Contractor, the contract will be stand as cancelled.
- 7) The Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right to revise the quantity of the tendered article/item as per requirement and/or availability of fund within the validity period of tender which is 01 (one) year.
- 8) The Commissioner of Police, Kolkata may accept the tender in respect of all the items tendered for, or any of them, or any part of all or any of them, by notifying the Contractor accordingly and the tender shall thereupon be considered as a tender for the quantity so accepted.
- 9) The Commissioner of Police, Kolkata reserves the right to invoke and/or cancel the Supply/Firm Order, if situation so warrants or the terms and conditions are not complied with, without assigning any reason thereto.

VII. GROUND FOR BLACKLISTING

a) At the Stage of Competitive Bidding – on the ground of :

- vii) Any documented unsolicited attempt to unduly influence the outcome of bidding in his favour,
- viii) All other acts that tend to defeat the purpose of competitive bidding which is contrary to financial rules of the Government e.g. habitual withdrawing from bidding except valid reasons, not complying with the requirements during bid evaluation.

b) At the Stage of Contract Implementation – on the ground of :

- i) Failure on the part of the firm to supply items as per Supply Order/Work Order due solely to his fault or negligence within the prescribed period as mentioned in the detailed tender notice.
- ii) Failure to fully and faithfully comply with the contractual obligations without valid cause or failure to comply with any written lawful instruction of the procuring entity or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the contract.
- iii) Assignment and sub-contracting of the contract or any part thereof
- iv) Unsatisfactory progress in the delivery/execution of goods/items/work in case of procurement,
- v) Supply of inferior quality of goods/service/work, as per accepted specification/sample/ specimen of item(s).
- vi) Any other reason, which the procuring entity deems it logical to include in the contract, duly agreed by the Contractor.
- vii) Failure of supply/execute within the stipulated period of time to be mentioned in the supply order/work order.

VIII. DISPUTES & ARBITRATION

In case of any dispute or differences, relating to the terms of this agreement, the said dispute or difference shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Commissioner of Police, Kolkata or any other person appointed by him. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. In the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is referred to vacates his office on resignation or otherwise or refuses to do works or neglecting his work or being unable to act as arbitrator for any reason whatsoever, the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in the place of outgoing arbitrator and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed further with the reference from the stage at which it was left by the predecessor. The Bidder will have no objection in any such appointment on the ground that arbitrator so appointed is employee of Kolkata Police. The adjudication of such arbitrator shall be governed by the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof or any rules made thereof. The arbitration shall be held within the jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta.

IX. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

Kolkata Police may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract, terminate the contract in whole or in part by giving a notice of not less than 30 days to the contractor :

- a) If the contractor (Bidder) materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period(s) specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by Kolkata Police in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty (30) days after receipt of the default notice form Kolkata Police.
- b) If the contractor in the judgment of Kolkata Police has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing or in executing the contract.

X. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

The Bidder shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is a result of an event of Force Majeure. For purposes of the clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Bidder and not involving the Bidder's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, freight embargoes etc.
